A Head Course Facilitator is responsible for:

- Providing direction and leadership for the certification program in their province;
- 2. Overseeing the implementation of the certification system in conjunction with the Provincial associations which includes:
 - assisting in scheduling of courses
 - assisting in the selection and training of Course Facilitators to do the courses
 - assisting in the selection of sites to run courses and
 - recommending to the Master Course Facilitator who should be promoted to Course Facilitator status in their province in conjunction with the Provincial Associations.
- 3. Training the Course Facilitators, Assistance Course Facilitators and Apprentice Course Facilitators within their province.
- 4. Ensuring that Apprentice Course Facilitators are entering the system and being developed.
- Fulfilling the administrative requirements for each course level he/she delivers.
- 6. Delivering the content in a professional manner to the best of their abilities.
- 7. Conducting a suitable number of courses each year.
